All learning and teaching follows the National Curriculum (2014), except for music, which instead focuses on our own therapeutic music programme.

Extra-Curricular

All pupils attend 1:1 therapeutic music, sensory exploration, hobby development, massage and relaxation and play therapy/cognitive behavioural psychotherapy/counselling sessions each week

Pupils who require Speech and Language Therapy and Occupational Therapy are assessed by relevant therapists and a tailored programme is then integrated into the child's individualised curriculum plan.

PE sessions include standard curricular activities, plus horse-riding, swimming and outdoor pursuits.

Pupils take part in the preparation and performance of an annual concert for parents/carers/professionals.
